Road Safety

The roads around the school are generally 40 kph so please take care to keep to the speed limit so that you can stop quickly if a child steps out in front of you.

We need to be considerate of the people who live around our school. That means that we do not park in driveways as this frustrates the residents who need to get in or out of their property.

It is also illegal to park on the grass berm at the side of the road. **DO NOT** park on corners or on the dotted yellow lines. You will have noticed that there are signs around the school to remind you.

Children who leave school by the back gate and live on the left hand side of Coleraine Drive or go across the bridge to St James **DO NOT CROSS** the road. They **MUST** walk around the footpath at the turning area outside the school.

I have been advised that parents meeting children or living near Coleraine Drive are photographing cars parked illegally and sending photos to the Hamilton City Council.

Please be aware of road safety and be considerate of all neighbours.


