

Learning Engagement Approach

Alongside restorative practices, we implement a **learning engagement model** in all classrooms.

When students display challenging or disrespectful behaviour or behave in ways that interrupt the learning of others teachers take every step to quickly re-engage them in learning using the following strategies:

- Planning engaging and relevant lessons
- Differentiating the learning to meet student needs
- Setting and communicating clear expectations and routines
- Providing regular feedback to students
- Modelling appropriate behaviours
- Clearly communicating the 'Learning Engagement Model'

While there are situations that call for an individual approach, our general response is a **4 step process** outlined in our learning engagement model below:



All our actions are guided by a shared intent: to support all students in becoming confident, connected, actively involved lifelong learners and to prioritise positive relationships, respect for ourselves, others and property and personal, social and emotional safety of all.
