

- The school day will be from 9.00am to 2.30pm with only 30 minutes for lunch.
- Your child will meet you at the prearranged school exit at 2.30pm here will be no walking school bus to Countdown. Older children may be able to walk or ride home by prearrangement.
- To protect bubbles, there will be no supervision of students after 2.30pm so it is important that you are on time to pick your child from the front entrance at 2.30pm.
- Your child will be assigned to a 'bubble' with no more than 10 students. Your child may be with different staff members throughout the day. Where possible they will remain with similar aged children.
- Your child will remain in their assigned bubble for the entire day. Therefore both morning tea and lunch breaks will have learners remain inside. The playgrounds will remain closed throughout Alert Level 3.
- This will mean a different approach to classroom life than they are currently used to.
- Hand hygiene and school hygiene will remain a top priority.

These are just some of the immediate health and safety practices that we are putting into practice. As we receive more information from the Ministry of Education we will revise our Covid-19 Health and Safety Plan and keep you fully informed of any updates and/or changes.

For now, we will continue to support your child's learning by distance while we progress our planning for what Alert Level 3 will mean for you and for our school. We will be in touch again soon with more information. As you have been doing, please keep connecting with your teachers with any questions you might have.
