### **The Playground will be Open**

Our focus will be on washing hands before and after every break time.

### **Sports and Physical Education**

At this stage our sports and physical activity will continue. Again our focus will be on washing hands before and after use, and sports gear will be regularly cleaned.

### **Celebration Assemblies, Team Assemblies and School events**

At this stage, we will not be holding these as they would be bringing together large groups of people. Please understand that this Friday's celebration is cancelled.

### **Student Absence**

All well students should be attending school during Alert Level 2, if absent for any reason, please follow the usual processes to advise of your child's absence:

### **Before and After school care**

Before and after school care will be operating as usual, with bookings available using the same process. If your child is new to this service, you will need to make contact with the team at [kiwiclub05@hotmail.com](mailto:kiwiclub05@hotmail.com) Please be aware numbers may be limited.

The kiwi club will have a staff member at a desk near the covered court at the end of the day where you will be asked to sign your learners out. They will notify the hall and have your child join you outside.

### **Our School Day**

Students cannot enter classrooms until 8.30am. We suggest that students arrive at school close to 8.45am. Unless booked at after school care, all students are to be off site by 3.05pm. We appreciate your support with this.

### **Reminders**

Keep any students who are sick at home until they are well. Keep reminding them about the importance of hygiene and washing their hands. Ask about their school day and stay connected to us via email.
