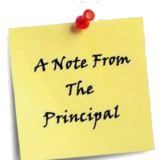

Family of **TWO** or more students will be \$150 for the year paid in FULL

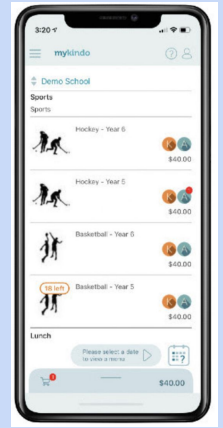
From 1 April the donation will be as follows:

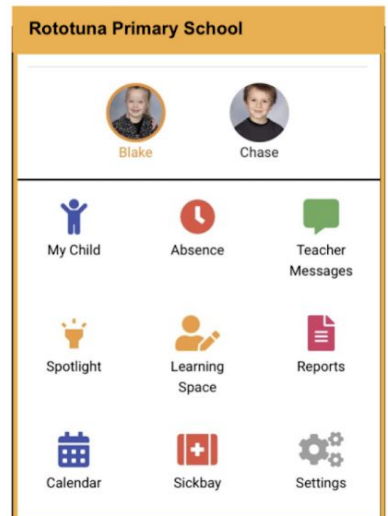

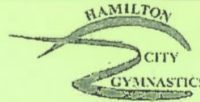
